This letter is to inform you of a price increase which has become necessary & unavoidable. At our last Board of Director's meeting held on January 24th, it was determined that we are not meeting our operating costs and haven't for some time now. We are a privately-owned, non-profit, association. We rely on donations received through our annual appeal letter as well as monies we receive in exchange for use of house facilities. East flampton Sports Camp has been meeting here since August of 1992 at a rate of \$15.00 per hour. It is no longer possible for us to maintain that price. Utilities, taxes, insurance, and basic maintenance of the building increase each year and now we must follow suit. The new meeting fee will be \$30.00 per hour. I realize that this is quite a jump but we tried to delay it as long as we could. I hope this does not cause too much inconvenience. I have notified you as soon as I was made aware. I'm sure you'll be able to pass this increase onto your students or possibly add a few to make up the difference. The pessimist would say it's a huge increase, but the optimist would say \$15/hr over three years was a bargain. Although there's no room to compromise, feel free to call me if the need arises.
