That he is an Assistant Trust Officer of Underwriters Trust Company, a corporation organized under the Banking Law of the State of New York and duly authorized to act in a fiduciary capacity in this State. That deponent is familiar with the matters set forth in the foregoing Account.

That said Trust Company, by order of this Court dated the 20th day of January, 1937 and duly entered herein in the Office of the Clerk of the County of Suffolk and made pursuant to the provisions of the Shackno Act, being Chap. 745 of the Laws of 1933 (or the Mortgage Commission Act, being Chap. 19 of the Laws of 1935), was duly appointed Trustee for the holders of the mortgage investment in respect of the premises known as West Side of Deer Park Avenue, Babylon, County of Suffolk, State of New York, and, under date of January 22nd, 1937 duly executed the Declaration of Trust provided for by said order. Said Trustee herewith files with this Court the foregoing Annual Account, dated May 21st, 1940 and signed by said Trustee, for the anniversary year ending February 16th, 1940 pursuant to Section 14-a of said Mortgage Commission Act (and the provisions of said Declaration of Trust).
