Smith, Jr. submitted a report on the constitution and it in suggested that the Board go back to a seven man directory which would require a quorum of for directors; that an Advisory Board of interested persons be appointed. The Committee on the constitution and by-laws - Raymond A. Smith, Jr., Mrs. Briggs, and Mrs. Usher, will make a written report at a later date.

Mrs. Skimore, in charge of the proposed fashion show and bridge for the fall reported that no definite plans had been made as yet, although contacts had been made.

A Nominating Committee was appointed with Mrs. Philip Gossler as Chairman, Mr. Raymond A. Smith, Jr., Mrs. James Skidmore, Mrs. James Briggs, and Mrs. John B. Usher, Jr. The committee will present its slate of officers and directors at the Annual Meeting of the Association on June 26th.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 11:55 A.M.
