Our chairs continue to be used by many privately - with a small up-keep donation of 15 cents a chair, and by many organizations which include the schools, Lions Club, Garden Club, churches, LVIS, Boy's Harbor, etc. Wedding, baby and birthday showers are scheduled as they come up during the year, - along with other activities as the need arises.

In the summers - mornings - our complete premises have been used by the East Hampton Boy's Club for over 35 years. This past summer the East Hampton Town Recreation Organization used our gym and grounds in a summer program for children.

Future scheduled time is arranged as the occasion allows.

This concludes my report which is a duplicate of a listing given to Mrs. Malcolm Aldrich. This - with a letter - was read by Mrs. Aldrich to members of the LVIS (finance committee) which she heads at this time; Its purpose being to promote a fuller understanding of the Neighborhood House for the LVIS.
