

The East Hampton Neighborhood House annual report
Resident Director Kammy Ball June 1983-June 1984

Since moving into the Neighborhood House in July 1983, my husband Don and I have seen increased interest from the public in using the House. We have been very receptive to peoples wants and needs and have had the house available to people for diverse activities. I have written up a list of all functions taken place since we have ^{been} here.

My first year with the Nursery School has been a delight. We had an enrollment of 30 children, a substantial increase over the last couple of years. I have received a great many compliments and favorable response from the parents of the children enrolled this past year. Mrs. Lisa Wirth and Ms. Patty Collins were hired in Sept. of 1983 as my assistants and will be returning this Sept. The assistants salaries are \$8.00 an hour opposed to \$12.00 an hour as paid in the past. We have increased tuition to \$45.00 a month, 5 days a week and have received no negative response from that. We have held both a bake sale and a yard sale to benefit the Nursery School this fall and winter. The total of both sales was \$550.00. Most of the money was used for school supplies with the remainder to be used for the start of school in September.

My husband Don has been taking care of the lawn by mowing in the summer and raking and blowing the leaves in the fall. He has made two new see saws for the children and has changed the swings from chain to rope. Don painted the screens for the windows and also painted the window trim downstairs and up.

The House has been extensively utilized this past year, with functions taking place most every week night and also on weekends. This summers schedual is very busy with the gym used every week night and also the club room 3 weeknights. As of now, a great portion of Saturday nights are already booked.

Both myself and my husband Don feel that our first year at the Neighborhood House has been very productive.
