Resident Director's report for Oct. 28, 1998

Showed pictures from the Town's 350th Parade that were given to me by Mrs. Mercer & Sheehy. They will be kept at the NHH for people to view.

I told members that I had put a letter in the Star thanking one of Emmie's school friends for filling in & helping represent us the parade (her name was not put in the Parade Program).

Advised Board that I had hired a new person to do our lawn as I was not satisfied with our other one. Tim Maxwell, Lynn Allen's brother has been hired & does a beautiful job.

Finally submitted an estimate from Geoffrey Kennedy to replace both front & rear entrance doors & children's bathroom threshold. The cost would be \$1880.00 not including plaster repair or painting if necessary. I have attached a copy of the quote here. The cost is only approx. \$100 more than one previously submitted by Dave Griffiths in May of 96 (Mr Griffiths had begged off on doing the job).

Finally, I asked if the Nursery Group employees could become eligible to collect pay on holidays & days off as we have no sick or personal days paid. The parcents pay full tuition for the month so we should be covered.
