Nursery School Attendance was much better this year than last. We had two helpers the whole term. We had 59 children registered and a daily attendance of about 50.

St. Matthew's Guild, The Maidstone Gun Club, The E. H. Ladies Republican Club and The Women's Service Club, have their regular evenings, and The General Good is distributed from here once a month.

Mrs. Robert Detault has Ballet lessons here two afternoons each week, and every now and then we have a shower of some kind going on.

Mrs. Kiernan uses the whole house two evenings a week - July and August only.

I'm sure our repair bill has been quite high. We had one side of the old part shingled, also the front roof of the old part, and a new cellar door. The repairs on the Bungalow in the year was high too - As the whole thing had to be painted inside and out, and
