The Neighborhood House opened for the season  
Oct 1<sup>st</sup> 1963. The Nursery School opened with  
47 Children registered. We have school Monday  
- thru Thursday 8.30 A.M. - or 9 A.M. until  
11.30 A.M. We have one paid worker to  
keep with the children, namely Mrs. Betty  
Venegas of Osborne Lane. The Church League  
Basket ball season opens Nov. 1<sup>st</sup>. They  
play Monday and Friday nights, and  
practice Tuesday Wednesday and Thursday  
St. Luke's, St. Philomena (or Most Holy Trinity)  
and the First Methodist Churches have two  
teams, and the First Presbyterian and  
Calvary Baptist have one team each.  
They finish for the season about  
March 1<sup>st</sup> but they still use the gym  
for practice. Mrs. V. Taubert gives Ballet  
lessons Monday and Thursday Afternoons.

Meets here every other Tuesday. The first  
Tuesday in the month a Covered Dish  
Luncheon is held here by the same group.  
The Service Club meets every Thursday night,  
The Women's Republican Club the second  
Tuesday of the month, The Maidstone  
Glee Club the second Wednesday of  
every month, and the Cub Scouts have  
their Pack meeting the last Friday in  
every month. The Population keeps  
increasing so we have a baby shower  
every so often. Also Bridal Showers and  
Birthday Parties. Mr. Kiernan's Boys  
Club have used the Neighborhood House  
5 Mornings a week in the past 4 yrs.  
and paid us \$150.<sup>00</sup> (this included gainey  
dolls too). This year they will be here  
5 Mornings a week and will pay us  
\$300.<sup>00</sup>



One more word about the Nursery  
School - The parents pay a fee of  
\$7.50 per month and half that  
amount for the second child  
if there are two children  
from the same family.

This year we had seven children  
whose parents couldn't afford to pay.

Last June (a year ago) we had a  
furniture sale, and you are sitting on  
the money! I bought 24 chairs at \$8.<sup>00</sup>  
each. Last week the furniture sale  
clean brought \$130.<sup>00</sup>. The clean up  
cost \$10.<sup>00</sup>. I would like to buy a  
small gas stove for our apartment  
and a Congokum rug for the kitchen  
floor - if the board approves.
