Dedication and Re-dedication of the War Memorial at Ashawagh Hall  
May 28th, 1989, One O'Clock P.M. (Sunday)  
Rain Date: May 29th, Two O'Clock, Rain or Shine (Monday)

At dawn, flag will be raised, then lowered to half-mast. The plaque to be dedicated will be covered. Participants in the ceremony will gather on the bridge on Old Stone Highway and march to the monument. Les Bennett will oversee the line up order, which will include Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, Color Guards from the U.S. Coast Guard, Riverhead National Guard, Springs Fire Department, American Legion, V.F.W. and any Veterans wishing to march. The roads will be closed off on Old Stone Highway from Springs Fireplace Road to the bridge and on Parson's Way. All participants will be asked to park their vehicles at the Springs School on School Street. The Springs School band will be seated near the monument.

Upon marching up and gathering at the designated areas:

1. Reverend Fred Schulz, Invocation.
2. Springs School Band plays.
3. Legion Chaplain Karl Schaefer introduces speakers. (Allotted time: 10 mins. each).
  - A. WW II: Cliff Hildreth (Speaker 10 minutes)
  - B. Reverend Paul Cunkle says re-dedication prayer for monument; Civil War, WW I and WW II plaques.
  - C. Placing of a flower by one representative each for Civil War (Mrs. Alice Rogers) and WW I (Donald Miller), followed by Mr. Hildreth, then WW II veterans placing flowers in front of appropriate plaque. (Girl Scouts will have baskets with flowers).
  - D. Korean War: Joe Ricker (Speaker 10 minutes)
  - E. Reverend Fred Schulz says prayer of dedication for Korean part of plaque.
  - F. Unveiling of Korean War Veterans Plaque (1/2) by Mr. Erwin Beckwith.
  - G. Placing of flowers in front of plaque by Mr. Beckwith followed by other Korean Veterans. (Girl Scouts will have baskets of flowers).
  - H. Vietnam War: John Behan (Speaker 10 minutes)
  - I. Springs Fire Department Chaplain Donald Walsh says prayer of dedication for Vietnam part of plaque.
  - J. Unveiling of Vietnam War Veterans Plaque (1/2) by Les Bennett.
  - K. Placing of flowers in front of plaque by Mr. Bennett followed by other Vietnam Veterans. (Girl Scouts will have baskets of flowers).
4. Springs School Band plays.
5. Twenty-One Gun Salute.
6. Present arms, raise flag while band plays National Anthem.
7. Taps are played.
8. Karl Schaefer gives Benediction.
9. Springs School Band plays.
10. Announcement of refreshments.
11. Call to Dismiss.
