The Hallock Lineage 9.10

I. Peter Hallock 9.10.11.12 Original Settler.

Born about 1600. Died ? as Fater a first at fat died in Estand.

Landed at Southold, L.I., from New England, 1640 with 12 others, all members of Presbyterian Church in Hingham, Norfolk, England, 100 miles N.E. of London. Peter Hallock was first of 13 to step ashore among the Indians on what is now known as Hallock's Neck, Southold. He purchased Oyster Ponds (Orient) from the Indians and returned to England and brought back to Southold his wife who had been a Widow Howell, together with her two children, Richard and Margaret Howell. The Indians had resold Oyster Ponds so Peter purchased a new strip frm the Indians, 10 miles west of Southold & two miles west of Mattituck, reaching, from L.I. Sound three miles to Peconic Bay. The west part of this strip is still owned by the Howell descendants and the Hallock homestead has justleft the Hallock family.

No official records exist in America which mention Peter
Hallock. The records of Southold previous to 1651 have all been
lost with the exception of two brief notices. His name does not
appear on any passenger list of the Massachusetts Historical
Collections (q.v.). The burial place of Peter Hallock is unknown.
The above facts have been handed down within the Hallock family
and appear in all Hallock Genealogies. "We have no positive
knowledge as to who the menwere who constituted this Southold
Church and any attempt to make a list of the early settlers must
be based on inference more than actual knowledge."

II. William Hallock, son of Peter

Born England about 1620. Died W. Mattituck (Aqueboue)
Sept. 29, 1684. His mother, Peter's first wife, died in England.
Burial place of William not known.

Married Margaret Howell 1640, his step-mother's daughter.

William left a will which is preserved in the ancient records
of Suffolk County, at Riverhead, L.I. and New York City, dated
Southold Feb. 10, 1682 and was proved Oct. 21, 1684.

The Documentary History of New York State, in a list of those taxed in the Township of Southold in 1675 gives:

William taxed on 361 pounds Sterling and John 82 pounds.

In 1683, three: William 236 pounds, John 80 pounds, Thomas 81 pounds.

In the same history the list of total inhabitants of Southold

Township in 1698 gives twenty-three of the name of Hallock.

FAMILY REGISTER.

Taken from the recollections of the conversations of Grandparents, in the first fifteen years of the writer's life.

Rev. Ebenezer White, Minister of a Presbyterian church at Bridgehampton, LongIsland, came in early life, (it is believed) with his parents from England to America: located themselves in Massachusetts near Boston, he had one brother by the name of Thomas, who lived many years in England, was master of a British Packet from England to America.

Ebenezer White, when ordained and settled at Bridgehampton, married a Miss Pierson, by whom he had three sons, Elnathan, Silvanus and Silas; also a daughter by the name of Hannah, who married a clergyman by the name of Rossiter; settled at Stonington, Connecticut.

Silvanus, second son of the Rev. Ebenezer White, was born 1704, was sent to Weymouth, near Boston, to attend a classical school, at 11 years of age,1715. Entered Harvard College, Cambridge,1719; graduated 1723, was ordained to the pastoral charges of the church and congregation at southampton, L.I. 1727, where he labored in word and doctrine, with almost uninterrupted health 55 years, till October 22nd,1782; when after a short illness of seven days, he was removed by death, in full possession of his mental powers, rejoicing in hope of a glorious immortality through our Lord Jesus Christ. His wife survived till July 24th-1783, just as many months as she was younger than her husband. Soon after the Rev. Silvanus White, was ordained at Southampton, he united in marriage with Miss Phebe Howell, only daughter of Hezekiah Howell, and Phebe his wife.

Mrs Howell's maiden name was Halsey; whose brothers and sisters amounted to eleven. Mrs White had two brothers, Hezekiah and Jedediah, who each left many descendents. Rev. Silvanus White and Phebe his wife, were the parents of nine children, Silvanus, Edward, Hezekiah, Daniel, Silas, Phebe, Ebenezer, Ebenezer and Henry; these all lived to marry except the first Ebenezer, who died at the age of fifteen months.

Silvanus, the eldest son of the Rev. Silvanus White and Phebe his wife, married Miss Eunice Herrick of Southampton, settled in Blooming Grove, Orange County, New York. Had four children, Phebe, Silvanus, Eunice and Nathan Herrick, Silvanus died a young man; the others married and have many descendents. Silvanus White and Eunice, his wife, lived to the advanced age of wighty years or more, and both died in one week. Edward, second son of Rev. Silvanus White and Phebe White married Miss Hannah Pelletreau, whose father, Francis Pelletreau, came when a child with his parents from France, at a time of persecution, when twelve protestant families fled to America. Edward White and Hannah, his wife, lived together ten years when he died, June 4th 1767, at the age of 36, at New Windsor, Ora nge Co. where he lived Left four children, Hannah, Edward, Mary and Phebe. Mrs H. White lived a widow, till March 1st-1810, she died 74 years of age. Hannah eldest daughter, married Charles Merrill of Hartford, Conn. Edward White, married Rachel, daughter of Mr. Harry Smith, Newburgh moved to Geneva 1795; had four children, 1 son and 3 daughters, Sophia, Harry Smith, Phebe and Mary. Mary died at the age of 12 years. Edward White died August 1827, age 65 years. Harry S. White and wife both died Oct. 1833, within a few days of each other, leaving two small children. The two eldest daughters married and have families of children.

Mary, second daughter of Edward and Hannah White, died Dec. 27th-1798 age 33. Phebe, the youngest child of Edward and Hannah White married Reuben Colton, of Enfield, Mass. Mr. Colton died June 21st-1823, in the 61st year of his age at Geneseo, Livingston County, New York.

Hezekiah, third son of Rev. Silvanus White, married Miss Abigail Sayre ofxmanihampkan Bridgehampton, L.I. settled at Blooming-grove, Orange Co.N.Y. They died and left six children 3 sons and 3 daughters.

Daniel, the fourth son, who was a physician, located himself at Westchester, married Miss Euphemia Bartow; he lived much beloved and died much lamented in the Autumn of 1781. His widow survived him only a few years leaving six children, 2 sons and 4 daughters; Phebe, Bethsheba, Matilda, Daniel, Euphemia, and Theophilus.

Silas, the fifth son, settled at New Windsor, Orange Co.

New York, by trade a silversmith, married Miss Sarah Newson.

They left five children, James Tiley, Silas, Levi, Harriet and Robert. Phebe, only daughter of Rev. Silvanus White and Phebe his wife, married James Tiley of Hartford Conn. had only one child who died immediately after its birth. Mrs Tiley died Oct. 26th 1782, four days after her f ather.

Levi, third son of Silas White, was born at New Windsor, 1787; married Miss Ellen Cox in New York in 1813, they have 7 children, 3 sons and 4 daughters. Adelia was born in 1814, Elvira I. was born in 1816, Charles W. was born in 1818, George N. was born in 1821, Robert was born in 1824, Harriet was born in 1829, Elnora was born in 1830.

Ebenezer White, M.D. the 7th son, married Miss Helen Bartow of West Chester, sister to Mis Daniel White. They settled at Yorktown, Westchester Co. both lived to an advanced age. The eldest child, Catherine, married Dr. Strang of Peekskill, had a numerous family, they were both numbered with the silent dead before the death of their mother White. Dr. Ebenezer and Mrs White left six sons, Bartow, Ebenezer, Henry, who are all three M.D's., Lewis, James and Theododius, most of these have numerous families. Lewis, the fourth son died Sept. 1836, at Peoria, Ill. whither he went on business, leaving a widow and twelve children to lament the loss of a most affectionately tender husband and parent.

Dr. Henry White, the 8th son, is still living at Southampton, L.I. at the advanced age of 88 years. He married first a
lady from Middletown Conn., who was daughter of Rev. Nath'l
Eells of H. with whom he lived for some years, after her death he
married Miss Ann Stephens, by whom he had children; Hannah Eells,
Silvanus, Phebe and Ann, who died in infancy. Silvanus married
and has one son. Phebe married James Parker and died in about
a year, left an infant three weeks old, whom the mother named
Ann White. The next year Capt. James Parker married Hannah E.
White, his wife's sister.
